



# Guidance Note for Application to the European Tracks 2022/23

### **EPICUR European Tracks**

In the academic year 2022/23, EPICUR will offer European Tracks in nine interdisciplinary challenge areas in the fields of Sustainability and European Identities, open to all students at EPICUR universities from their second year of studies. Embracing the spirit of Liberal Arts and Sciences, you can put together your own tailored curriculum. EPICUR will offer over 40 courses (previously advertised as "Liberal Arts and Sciences") as part of the European Tracks 2022/23 (see <a href="here">here</a>).

Of these offers, you can apply for <u>up to three</u> European Track courses. We recommend applying for courses within one challenge area or in key competences. However, you may also apply for only one course and also for courses across challenge areas. Make it your personalized study trajectory that is meaningful for you.

### When can I apply?

The main registration period for courses in the autumn term (course start: between September 3rd (registration before August 31<sup>st</sup> required) and December 31st 2022) will take place from **August 24th** – **September 18th 2022**. A separate registration cycle for courses in the spring semester (course start: January 1st or later) will take place in winter.

# Step-by-step Guide

# **Step 1: Eligibility**

You are eligible to apply for an EPICUR mobility if you are enrolled at an EPICUR partner university.

# **Step 2: EPICUR Inter-University Campus (EIUC)**

Guidance Note for Application

Register on the EPICUR Inter-University Campus (EIUC) with your home university email account (other email accounts are not accepted).

### **Step 3: Admission criteria**

Check and confirm that your application complies with the general EPICUR admission criteria:

- 1. You are enrolled at an EPICUR partner university you will be requested to upload proof of enrolment.
- 2. You are enrolled in min. the 2nd year of your Bachelor program you will be requested to upload a transcript of records.
- 3. You fulfill the language requirement (if applicable). If not stated otherwise, for courses in English, self-reported language proficiency is sufficient. Please describe in a document how you acquired your English level.

# **Step 4: Start application**

Check out the European Track information on EIUC that will link you to the course catalogue. Apply online by clicking on the 'apply now' button. There, please complete and upload the requested information and documentation. You can save and reopen your application form to complete it later.

Important: Please apply for up to three courses. If you apply for more than one course, please include a ranking of your preference in your motivation statement. We recommend applying for courses and EPIC Missions within one challenge area or in key competences. However, you may also apply for only one course and also for courses across challenge areas. Make it your personalized study trajectory that is meaningful for you.

# **Step 5: Submit application**

Submit your completed application online by **September 18th, 23:59**.

## **Step 6: Acceptance / rejection**

By the last week of September, we will notify you by email of the review and selection results. If your application is successful, you will soon receive further information about participating in the European Track!
